




Biology students explore a range of Biological concepts such as Cell Biology, Genetics, Biodiversity and Disease.



#### Art



The art content aims to challenge students' skill set and build on their prior knowledge, supporting students in establishing themselves as independent artists.




Criminology

#### Sociology



#### **Psychology**








In Psychology students explore key theorists and case studies. They examine how these studies explain the world around us.






Sport students cover a range of units looking at health and fitness, leadership and the human body.

Sport Double students cover these units in addition to those studied in the single qualification.




Students in Health and Social Care study a range of issues including growth and development, the Health and Social Care industry, and ethical issues.



#### **Business Single**





#### **Business Double**




