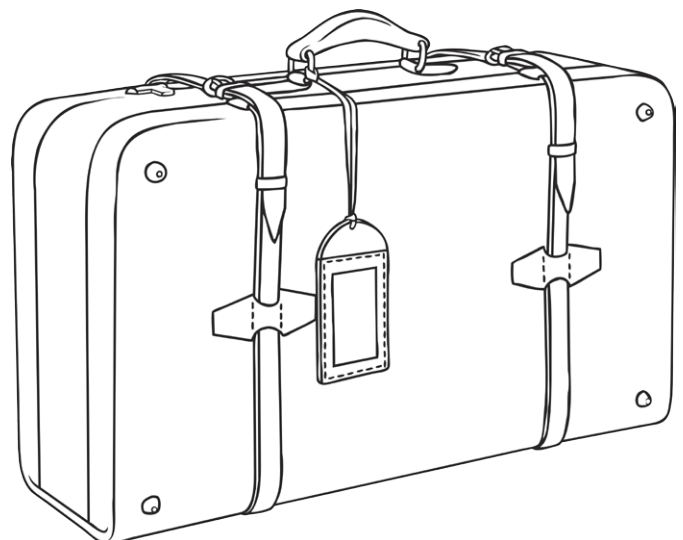
Why Do People Travel?
